

FREAK SCOOTERS EXHIBITED

Moving Pictures Taken of Nat Roe's Motor Scooter, Van Anden's Aero-motor Scooter and R. M. Sharp's Sailing Scooter

Quite a number of Patchoguers went to Lake Ronkonkoma last Saturday and indulged in what will probably be the last scootering of the season. Nat Roe's motor scooter, Van Anden's aero-motor scooter of Islip and R. M. Sharp's new racing sail scooter were used and the Pathe Frere Motion Picture Company had a representative there to get a picture of the three kinds of scooters. The boats raced about on the soft ice, not evincing much speed but causing considerable excitement by sailing through the air-holes. It is said that Roe's boat showed a great deal more speed than Van Anden's, which goes by an air-ship propeller raised above the boat. Some of the occupants of the boats were drenched and as one of the boats tipped and began to sink in an air hole Albert Latham leaped to the ice and fell, receiving an ugly gash near his eye. The motion-picture man was greatly pleased with the manoeuvres of the boats and it is thought the film will be a fine one, showing the occupants as clearly as the boats.
